Semester - III	C-5	History of India - III (c.750-1206)	Students will be acquainted with the evolution & political structure of Rajputs, Cholas, arrival of Arabians, Mediaeval Indian agrarian structure & social change, trade & commerce, religion, language & literature, art, architecture, style of temple architecture etc.
	C-6	Rise of Modern West - I	Students will be acquainted with the rise of modern west, economic expansion, industrial production, trade & commerce, early colonial expansion, renaissance, reformation & economic dev. of 16 th century Europe.

	C-7	History of India – IV (c.1206-1526)	Students of the department will be acquainted with the consolidation of sultanate in India, theory of kingship, Bahamani's, Vijyanagaram kingdom, trade & commerce, Bhakti & Sufi religious movements etc.
